J.D. students commencing study in 2022 or thereafter must meet Professionalism, Professional Identity and Cross-Cultural Lawyering requirements, which include the successful completion, with a final grade of "C" or higher, a cross-cultural lawyering course or seminar. The Academic Affairs and Curriculum Committee, in consultation with the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Committee, shall designate courses and seminars that are anticipated to include substantial emphasis on matters of bias, racism, and cross-cultural competence as eligible to fulfill this requirement. The Law School Records Office will publicize a list of courses and seminars that have been so designated. Courses designated as fulfilling this requirement shall not be treated as required courses for purposes of the grading norms (Appendix B).

Note 1: A student may not use the same course or seminar elected to fulfill the Professionalism, Professional Identity and Cross-Cultural Lawyering requirement to also fulfill another requirement such as the Upper-Level Writing Requirement or the Experiential Learning Requirement. *Student's initials:*
