



## Reciprocity Policy (Internal)

The Wayne State University Law School Career Services Office (CSO) will request reasonable reciprocal use of the career services resources of fellow ABA-accredited, NALP member law schools on behalf of Wayne State University Law School students and alumni on the following terms:

1. Full-time 3L and part-time 4L students currently enrolled in the Juris Doctor or Dual Degree programs, currently enrolled LL.M students, and graduates of Wayne State University Law School are eligible to request that the Career Services Office submit a reciprocity request.
2. Eligible students and alumni requesting reciprocity must complete and submit to the Career Services Office a Career Services Reciprocity Request Form. See the attachment.
3. The Career Services Office will submit reciprocity requests in compliance with the reciprocity policies of the institution(s) identified by the student/alum in the Career Services Reciprocity Request Form.
4. The Career Services Office will request reciprocity at only one institution in only one state per student/alum per academic semester.
5. Students/alumni who request and receive reciprocity privileges will not be eligible to submit another reciprocity request until six months after the expiration of the granted reciprocity privileges.
6. To preserve the opportunity for multiple students/alumni to obtain reciprocity privileges, the Career Services Office reserves the right to decline to submit a request for extension or renewal of reciprocal privileges.
7. The CSO reserves the right to modify this Reciprocity Policy at any time without prior notice.



## Career Services Reciprocity Request Form
