

EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING REQUIREMENT

All students must successfully complete, with passing grades or better, **at least six credits of curricular offerings that provide substantial instruction in professional skills** beyond traditional legal research, writing and analysis.

At least three of those professional skills credits must be fulfilled through a clinic or externship that provide substantial instruction in professional skills beyond traditional legal research, writing and analysis.

You can fulfill your requirement by taking 6 credits from column A, or by taking at least 3 credits from column A, with the remainder from column B.

Additional rules governing clinics and externships

- 8 credit cap on externships
- 14 credit cap on clinics and externships
- No more than one clinic/externship per semester
- A student may not take a second clinic unless positions remain available two weeks after registration begins
